David Heinze, our Associate Director of Music since 2019, will be moving to New York, where he will be the Director of Music & Organist at Christ Church (Episcopal). Bronxville. Vivian Blais, Director of Children & Youth, and her husband Cameron will be moving to Michigan to be nearer to her family and eventually grow their own.

Feasibility Survey Report and Some Very Good News!

Thanks to all who participated in our Capital Campaign Feasibility Survey. We had nearly 100 responses; 94% indicated that they supported the Organ and Mural Restoration Projects, with a similar percentage indicating that they would be willing to contribute over a period of 2 to 5 years. The vestry will be forming a committee to lead the campaign, and you'll be hearing more about that in the coming weeks.

In the meantime, we have received a most generous gift of \$2,000,000 towards the restoration and rebuilding of the organ. With the \$250,000 we had already raised, this not only allows us to proceed with the mural restoration and Phase 1 of the organ project (new console, front organ, and some portion of the back organ), but possibly to be able to complete the restoration of the entire organ. Our donors (who wish to remain anonymous) are hopeful that their gift will inspire the congregation's



involvement, allowing us to complete this monumental project. We are deeply grateful to all who have contributed, and will contribute in the future, to ensure that our noble and historic organ sings for many years to come.


